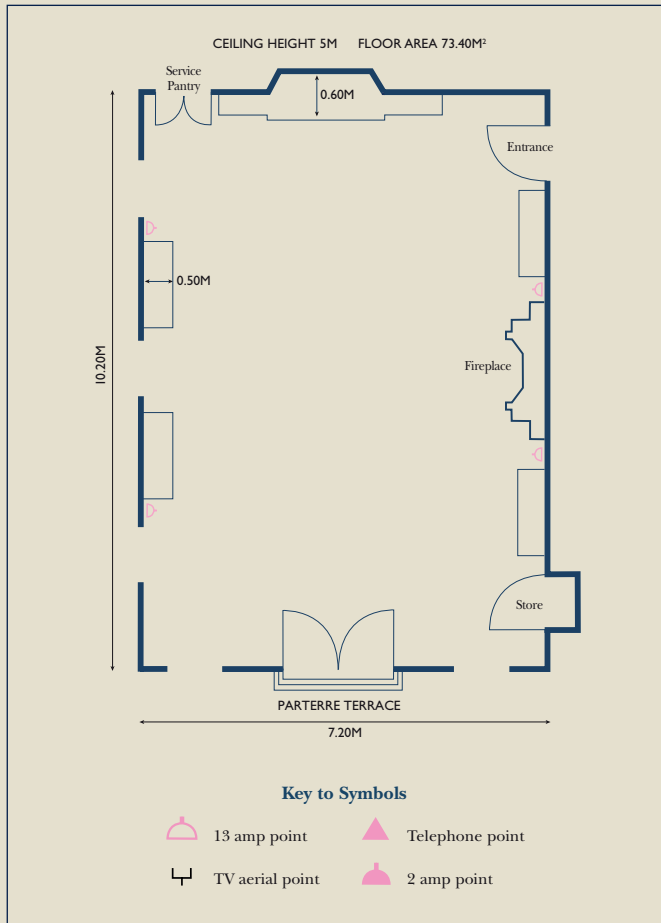

The French Dining Room is one of the most exquisite and dazzling rooms in the House, filled with light and beautiful views of the river and Berkshire countryside. On a visit to Paris in 1897 William Waldorf Astor was shown the intricate gilded panelling in Madame de Pompadour's 18th century dining room at the Château d'Asnières. Realising the proportions exactly matched those of the dining room at Cliveden he bought the panelling, table and chairs, then had the entire room reconstructed in his home. Seating up to sixty guests, this Rococo masterpiece provides an incomparable setting for a romantic wedding breakfast, impressive lunch or sumptuous dinner.
